The weather is forecast to be blowing a force 6 from the East which means you will have to go to the West coast which is sheltered from the wind. Choose a site/sites from the list below.

Using the trip participant list decide on buddy pairs for your chosen site, who & with what vehicles would do fills, what vehicles you will need to get to the site, create a timetable for the day & a rough cost for the day (decided if you are providing lunch for the trip as well)

Sun rise – 08:45

Sun set – 17:00

High Water – 11:00

Low water – 16:00

Your choice of dive sites are;

Site	<u>Loch Long – Aframes/Finnart point</u>
Distance	~90miles from Edinburgh, ~1hr 30mins
Parking	Ample & close to entry point. Free
Fills	Nearest fills are ~15miles away. Slow
Facilities	None
Site entry	Slope/steps to rock shore
Qual required	Suitable for OD training
Depth	0-40m
Description	Site is very gentle sloping rocky shore to ~3-5m leading to muddy slope, wreckage of concrete piers between 10 – 25m and provide interesting areas for wildlife. Silty slope continues to ~30m before becoming a very gradually sloping to 40m Site can be very busy so recommend getting their early in winter periods.

Site	<u>Loch Long – Conger ally</u>
Distance	~90miles from Edinburgh, ~1hr 45 mins
Parking	Layby space for ~6 vehicles & short walk to entry point. Free
Fills	Nearest fills are ~15miles away. Slow
Facilities	None
Site entry	Rocky shore
Qual required	Suitable for OD training
Depth	0-40m
Description	Site is very gentle sloping rocky shore to ~3-5m leading to muddy slope. Swim up loch between 10 – 25m to find rocky reef & conger eels. Access to site involves crossing busy main road so take care!

Site Loch Long – The Caves  
Distance ~100miles from Edinburgh, ~2hrs  
Parking Layby space for ~2/3 vehicles & next to entry point. Free  
Fills Nearest fills are ~15miles away. Slow  
Facilities None  
Site entry Crawl/waddle through tunnel & stride entry  
Qual required Suitable for experience SD  
Depth 0-40m  
Description Site is very steep wall, with cracks & cavens in the rock face for exploring. Site is sheltered by trees and above a stream so visibility is usually poor.

Site Loch Fyne – Caravan Site - Inveraray  
Distance ~115miles from Edinburgh ~ 2hrs 30mins  
Parking Ample parking ~£3 per car per day.  
Fills Fills available, phone in advance  
Facilities Toilet & shower  
Site entry Sandy/Silty shore, wade in  
Qual required Suitable for OD training  
Depth 0-25m  
Description Site is very gentle sloping silty/rocky shore to ~3-5m leading to muddy slope. Number of objects sunk amongst moorings including boats, trailers & a jeep.
